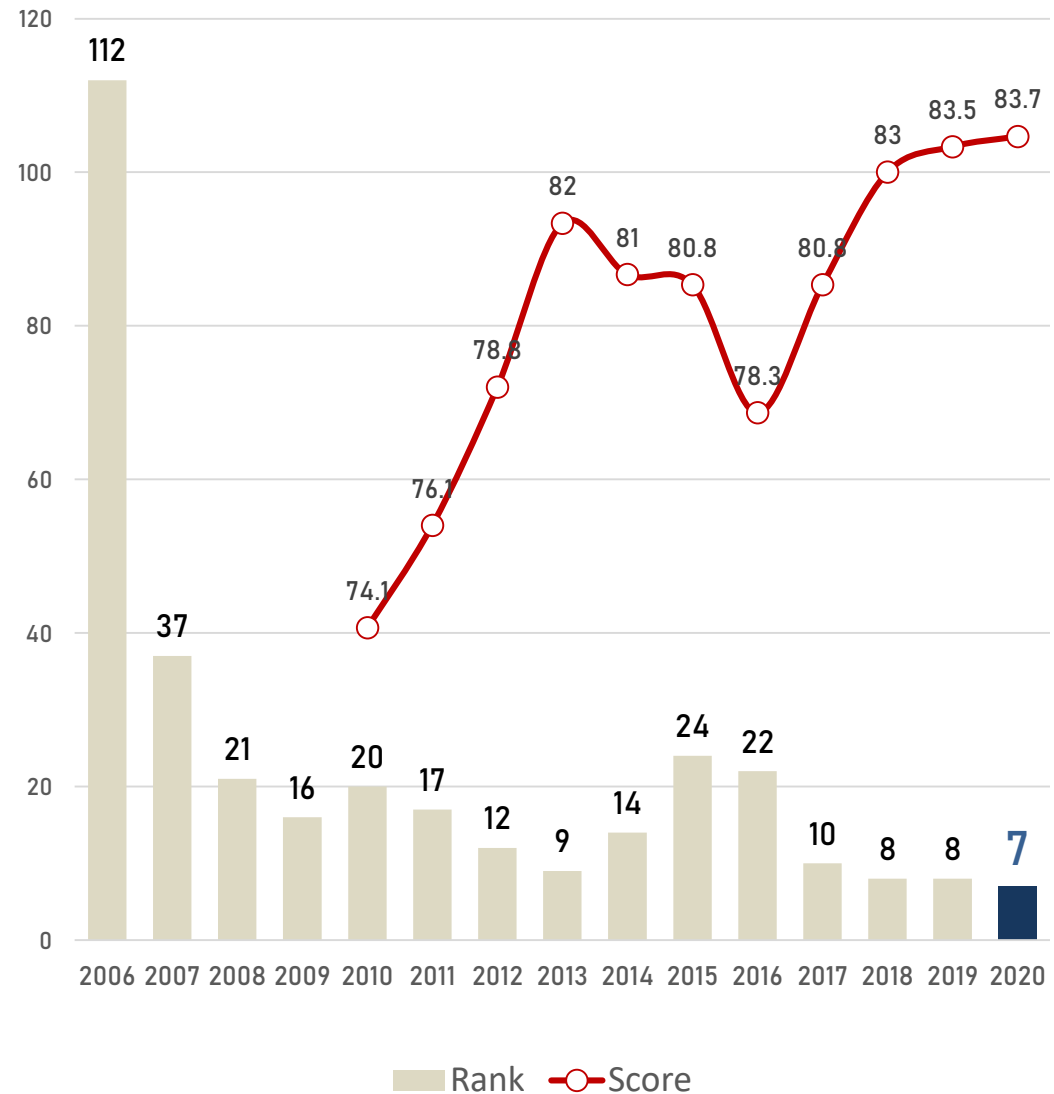

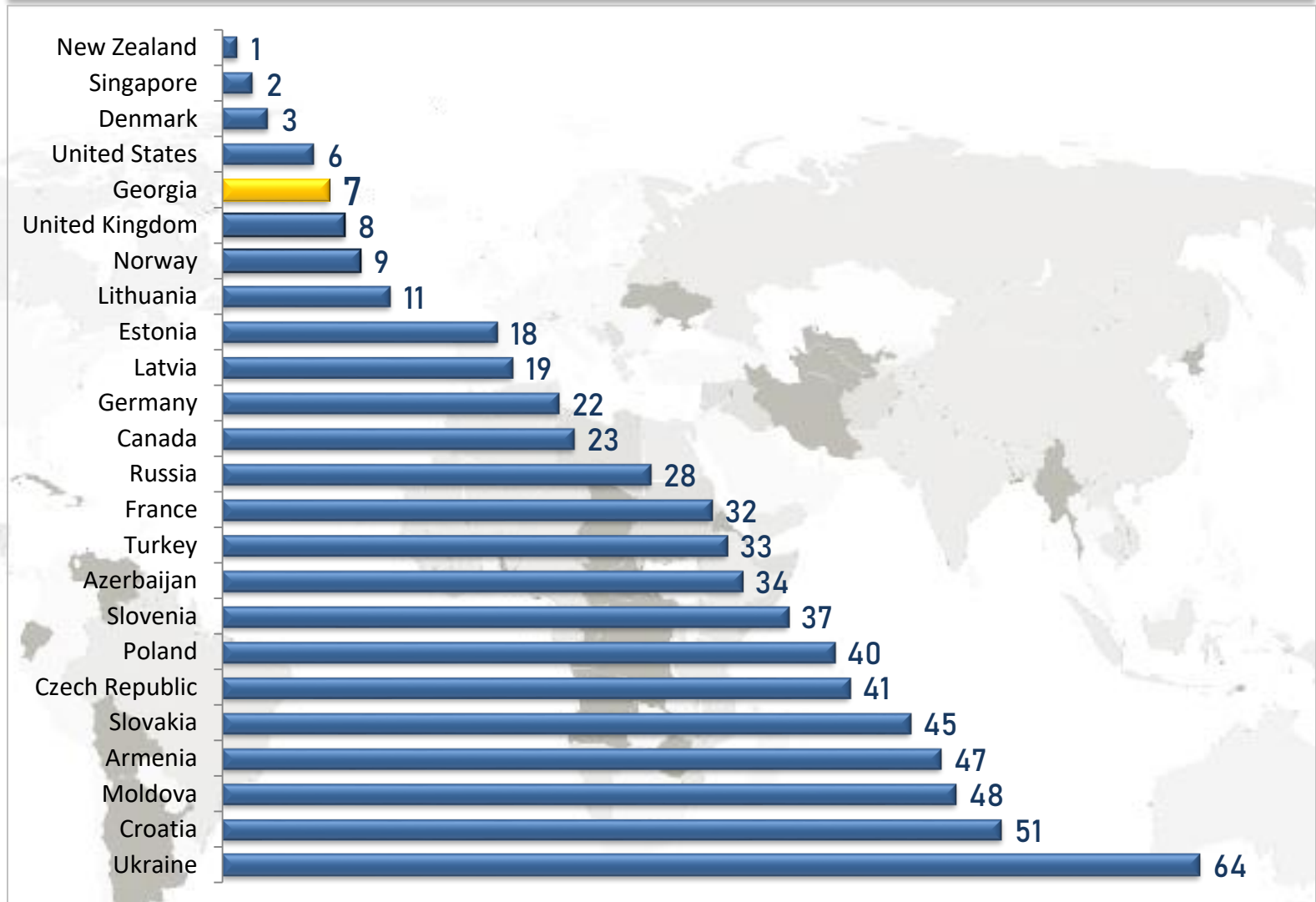

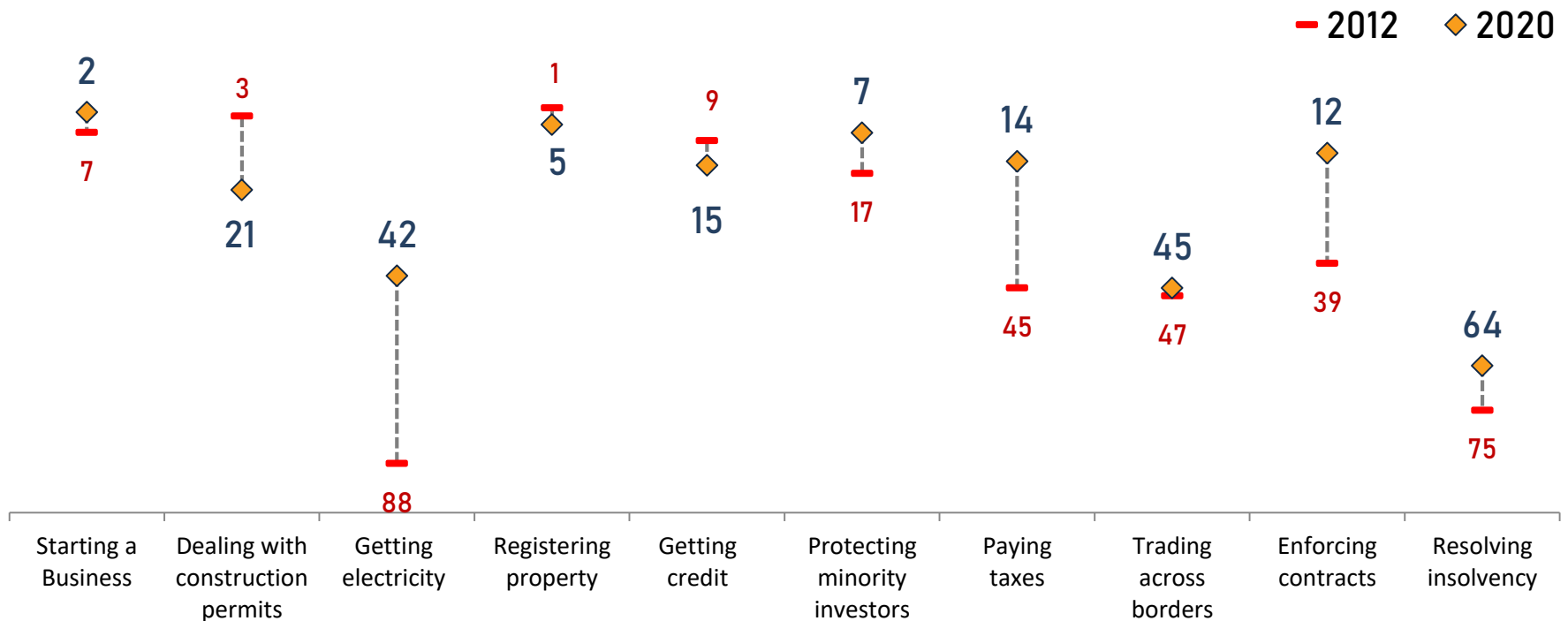

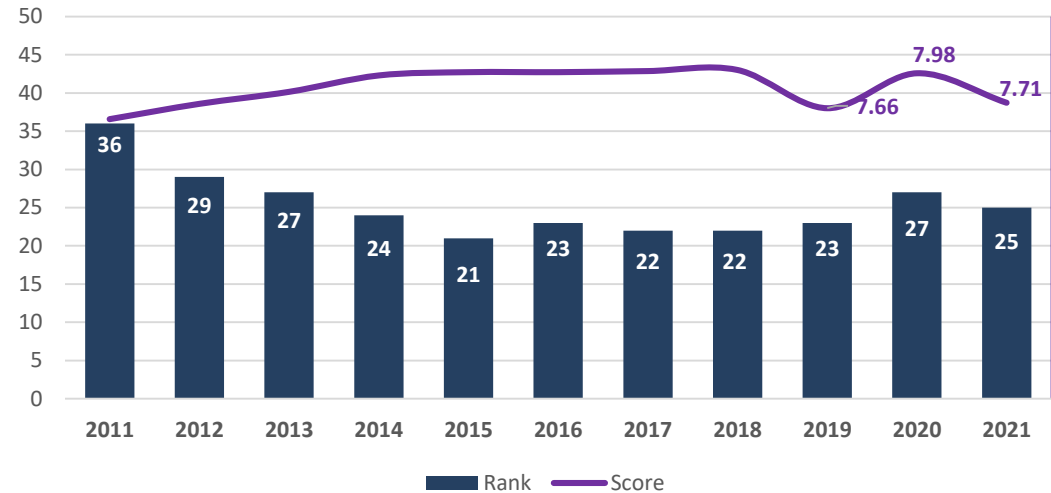

According to the “Economic freedom of the world” 2023 report, Georgia ranks 25th position among 165 countries worldwide with a score of 7.71.

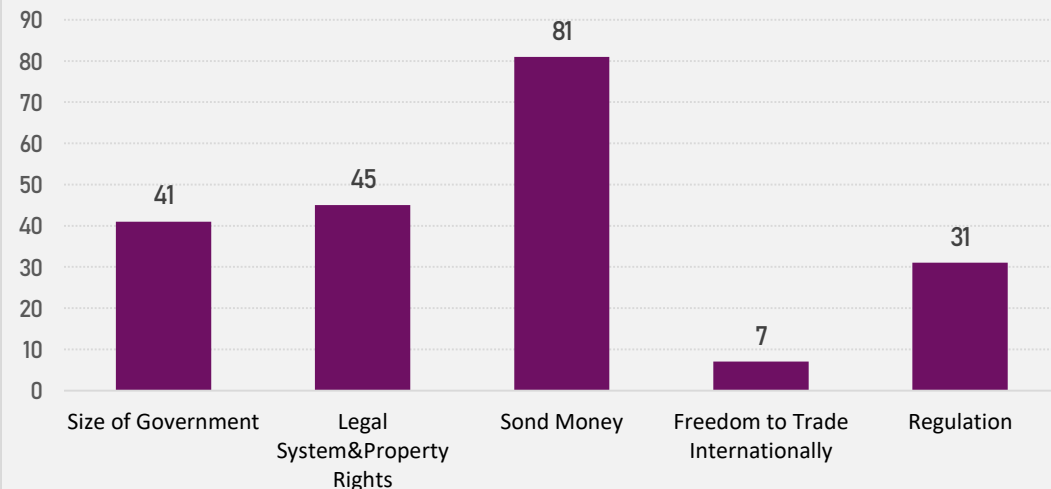
Georgia is evaluated in the rating with 5 indicators and 25 components

- Legal System & Property Rights – 45th position with a score of 6.33
- Sound Money – 81st position with a score of 8.74
- Freedom to Trade Internationally – 7th position with a score of 8.67
- Regulation – 31st position with a score of 7.40

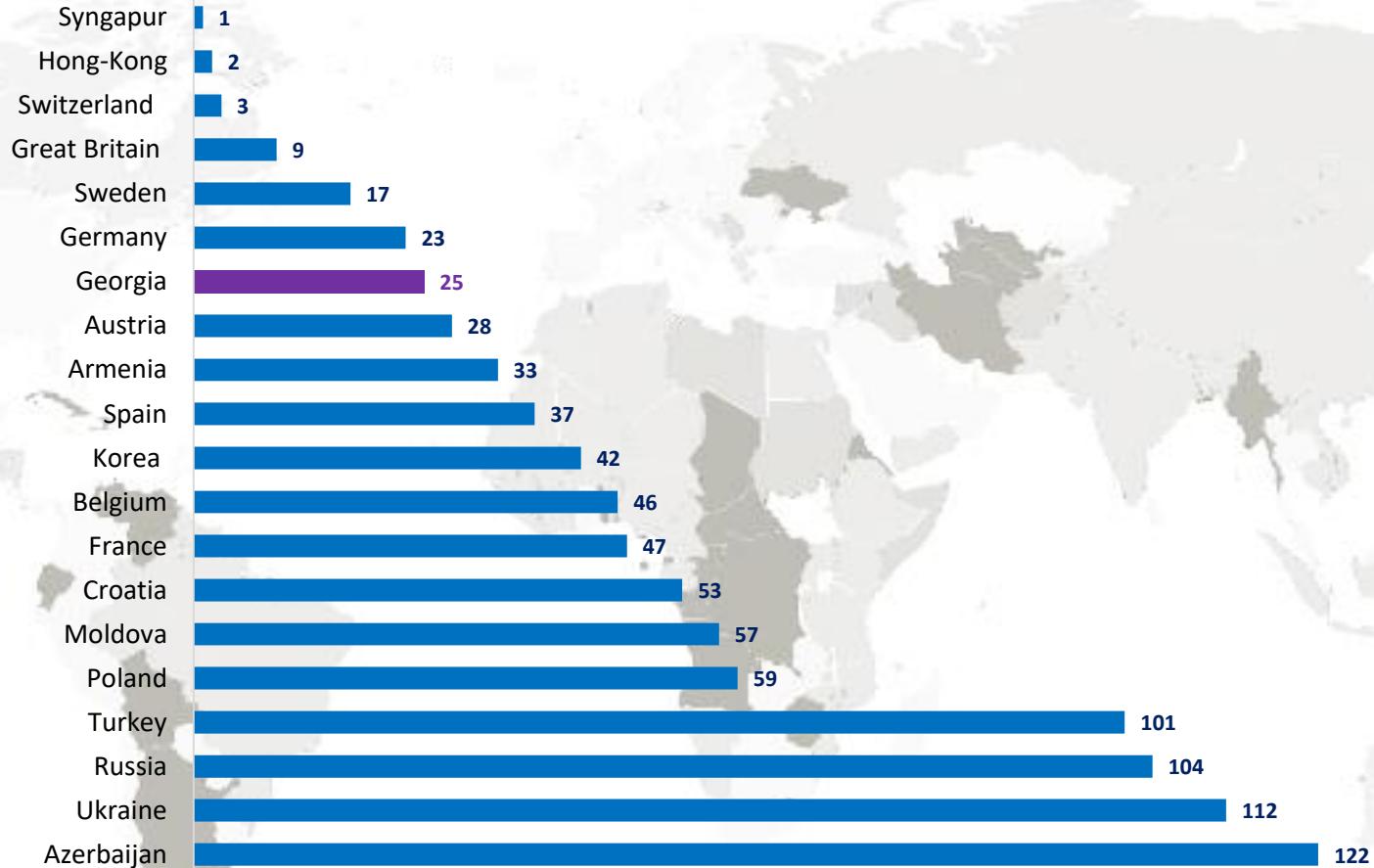


Georgia’s Position by the Indicators



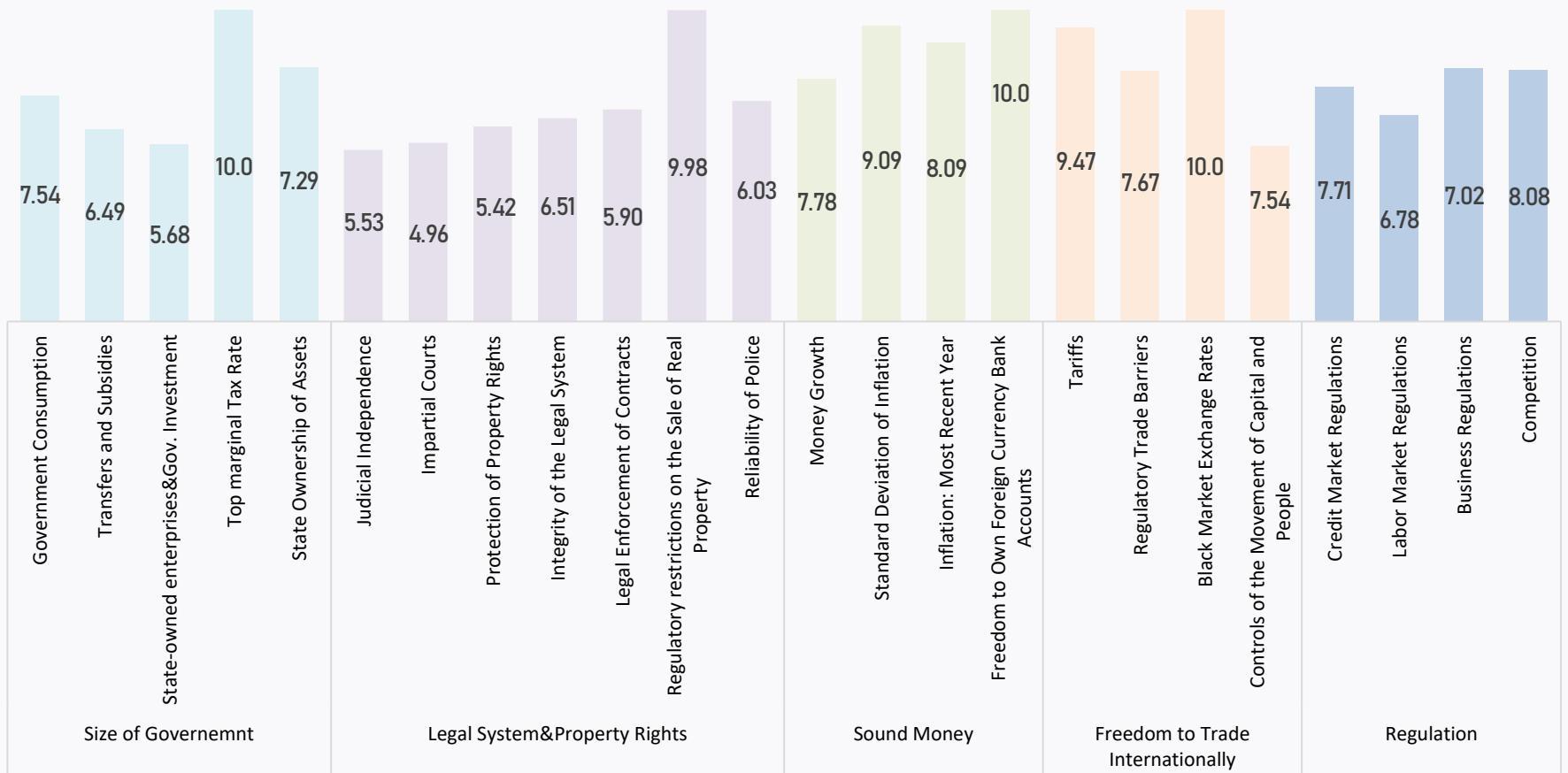

- ✓ In 2023 Georgia remains in the **Moderately Free Group**

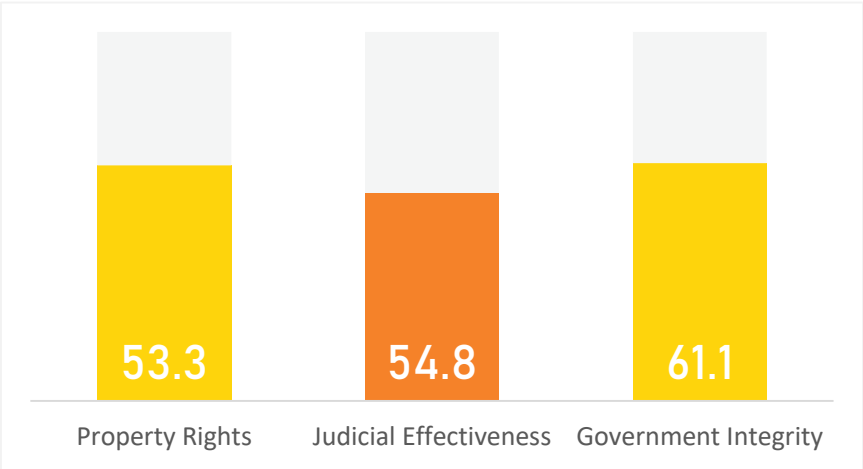

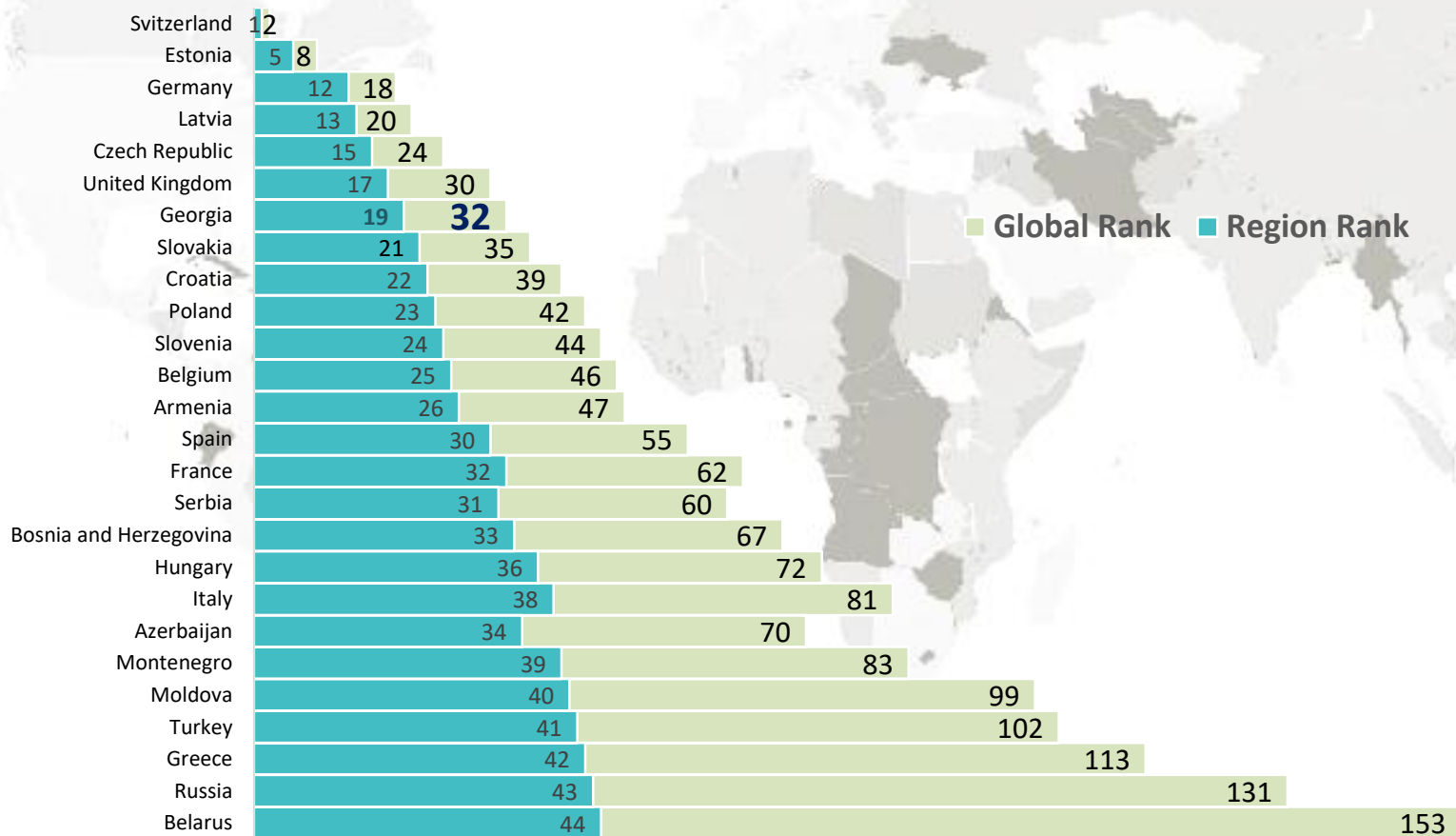

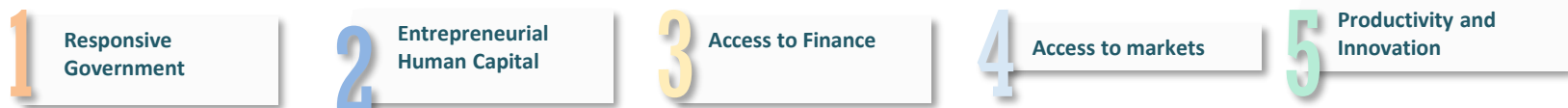
- The SME Policy Index – Assessing the Implementation of the Small Business Act for Europe is a unique benchmarking tool to assess and monitor progress in the design and implementation of SME policies towards EU and international best practices.
- According to the study by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) „**SME Policy Index - 2024**“ Georgia achieved unprecedented success:
- Georgia maintains a leading position and gained the highest scores in 11 out of 12 dimensions among the Eastern Partnership countries in the OECD ranking “SME Policy Index 2024”.
- Noteworthy, that Georgia was evaluated with the highest score in **9 out** of 12 components among Eastern Partnership countries

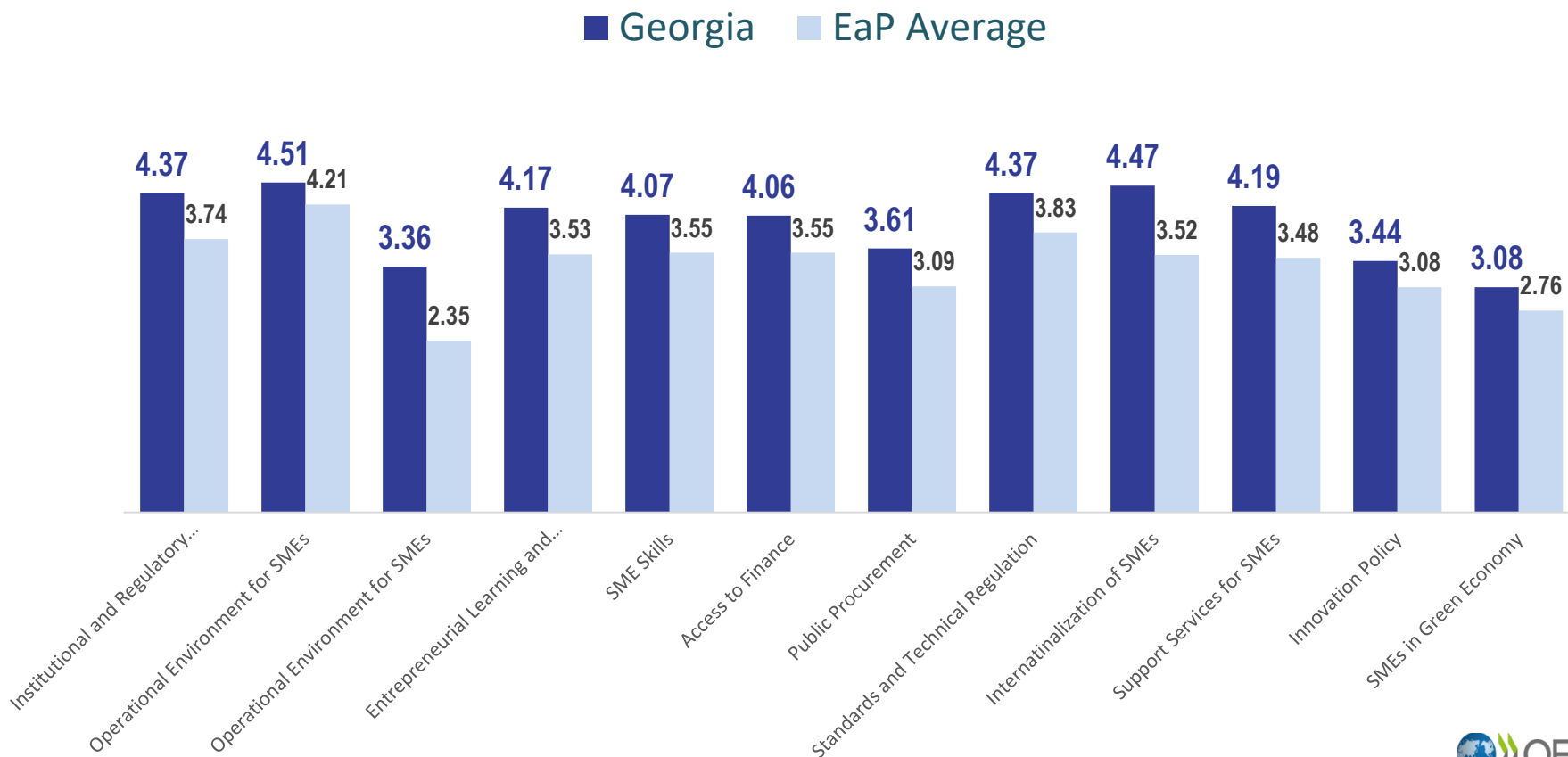

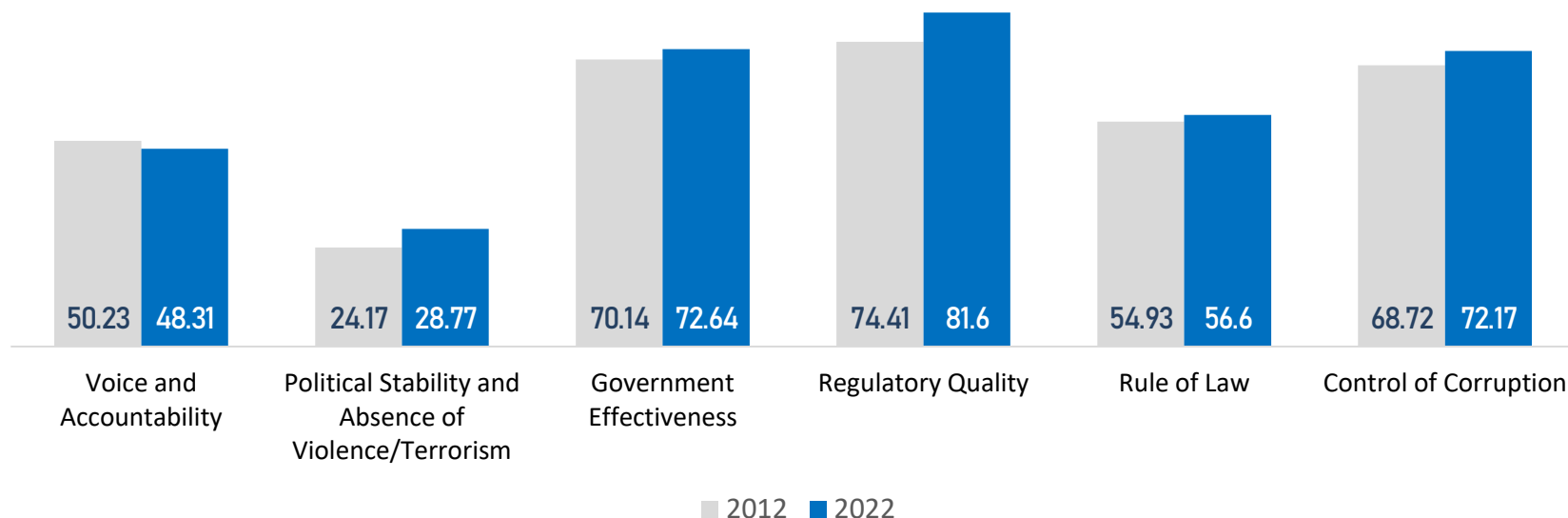

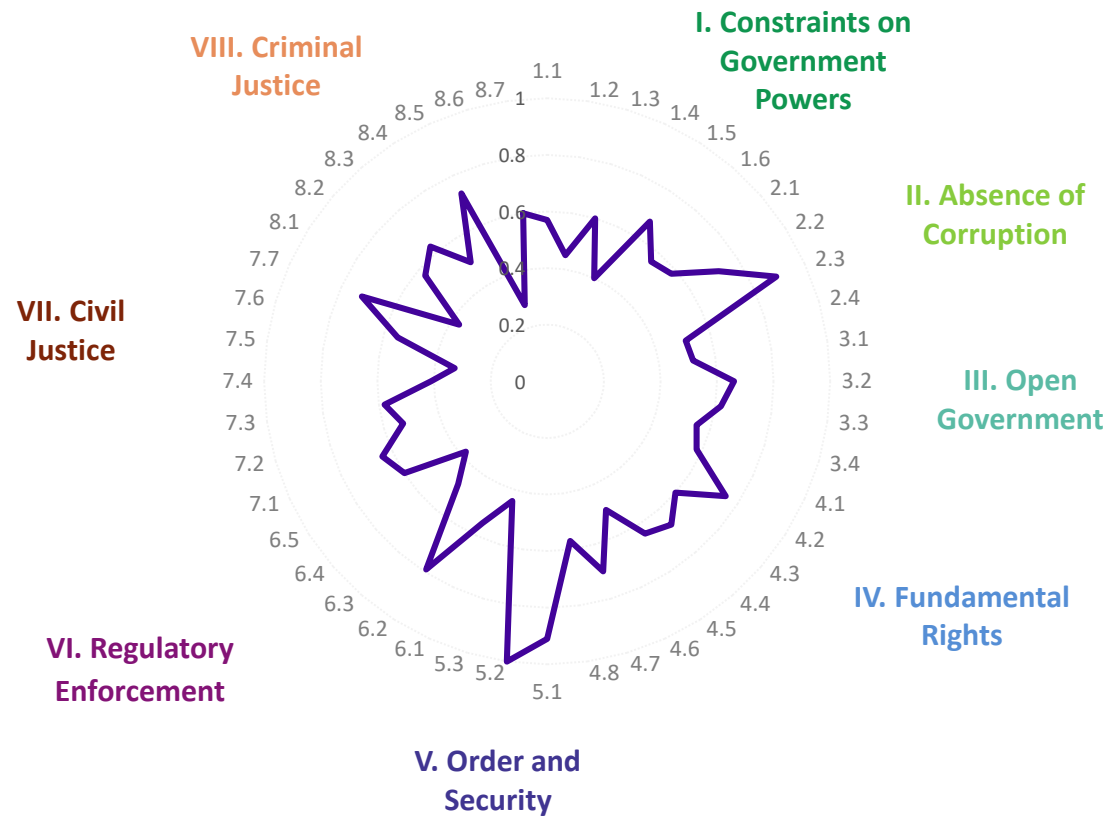

- Georgia is ranked the **first position** among the 15 countries in the region

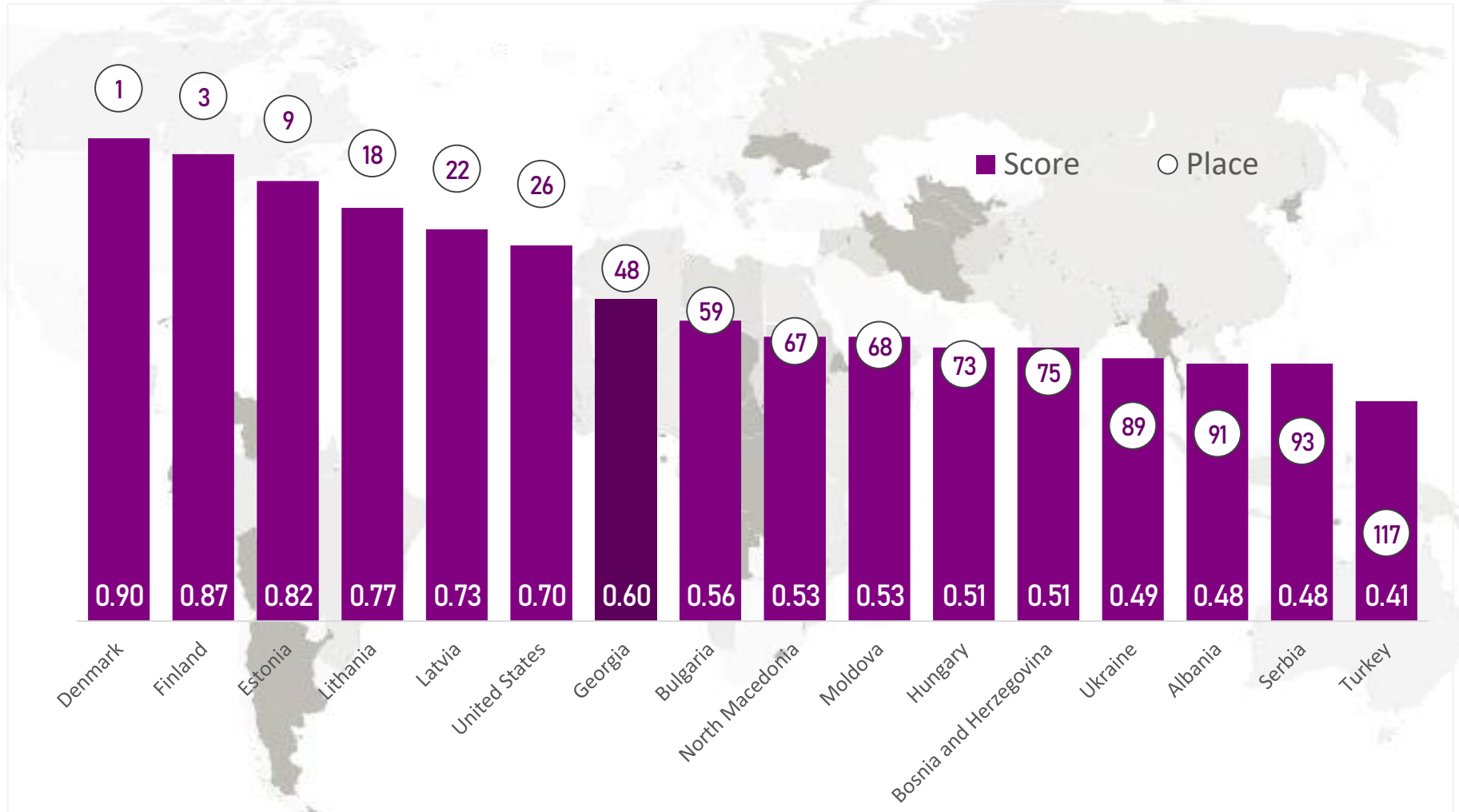

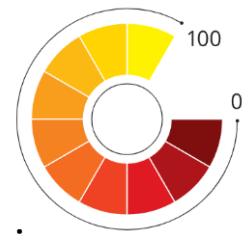

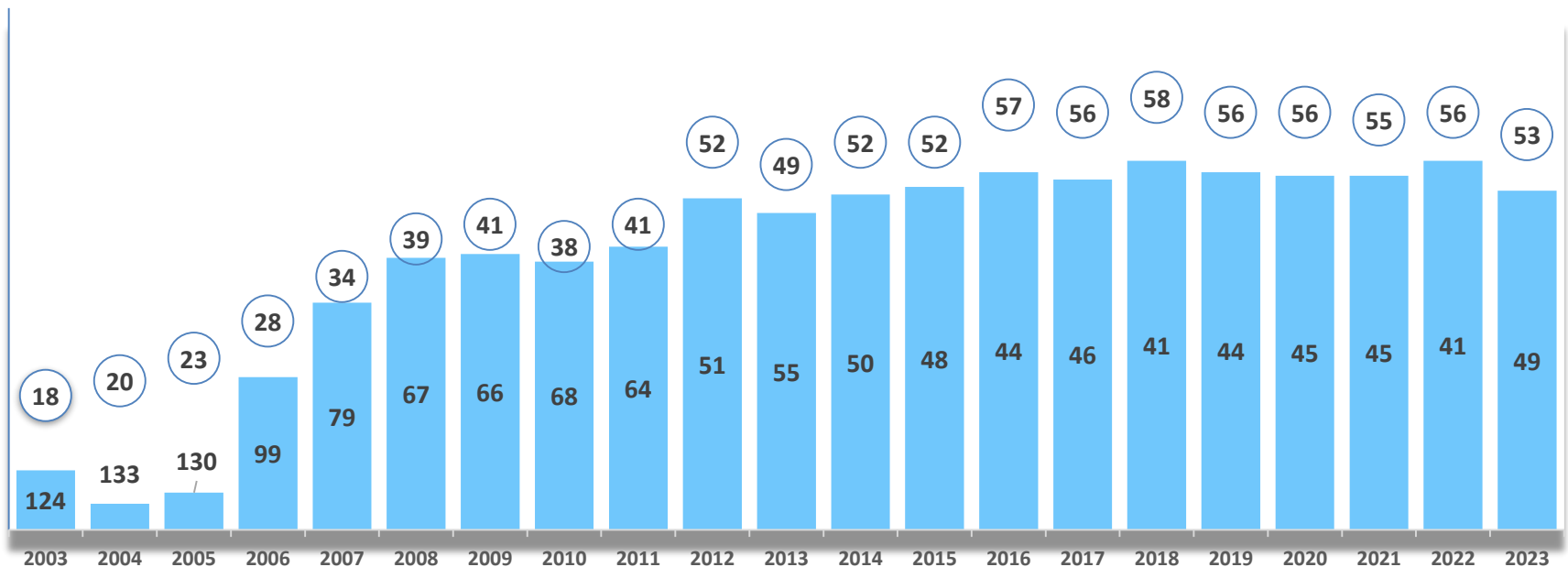

- Georgia is keeping **the first position** among the 19 countries in the Eastern Europe and Central Asia (EECA)

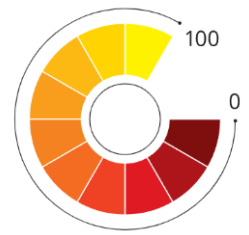

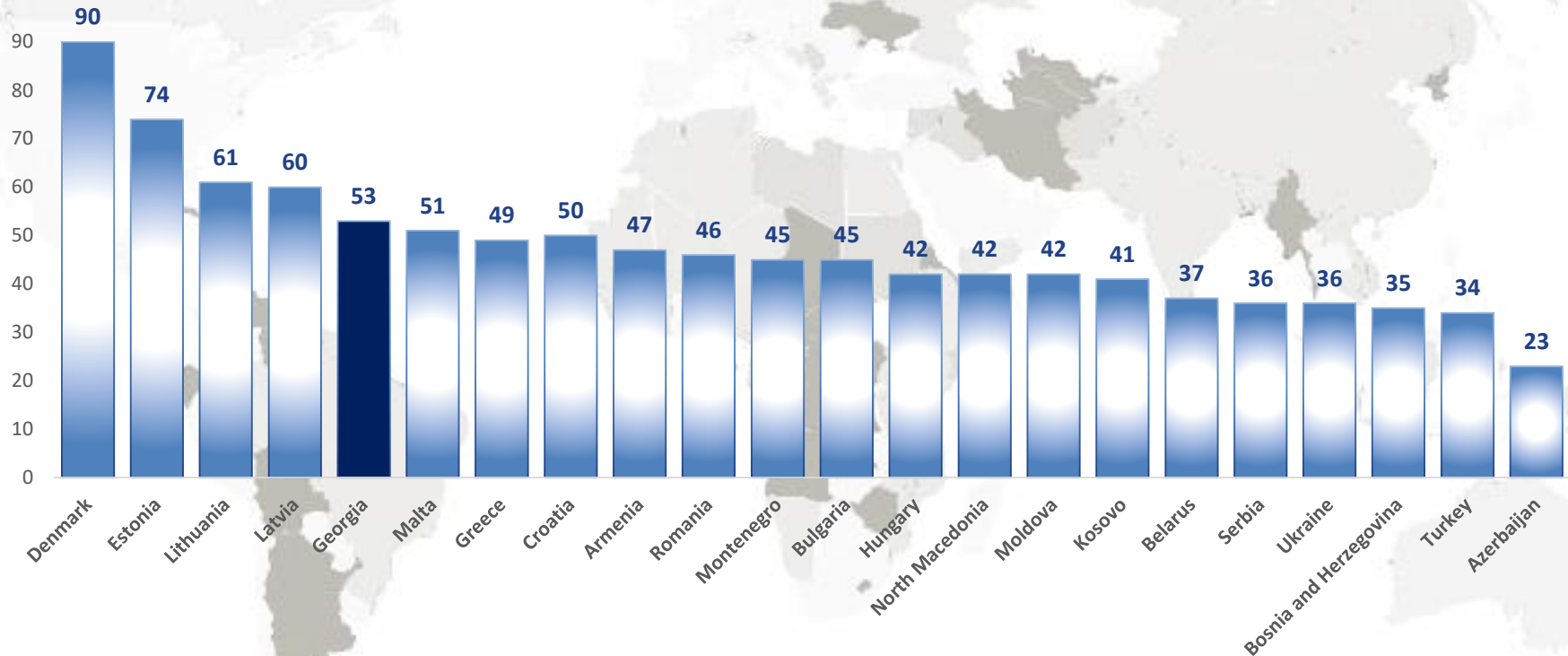

Bertelsmann Stiftung's "Transformation Index"

The BTI publishes two rankings, the **Status Index** and the **Governance Index**.

The Status Index ranks the countries according to the state of their democracy and market economy, while the Governance Index ranks them according to their respective leadership's performance.

Georgia among 137 economies in "**Status Index**" is in **52nd place with a 6.0 score** and in **38th place with a 5.5 score** in "**Governance Index**".

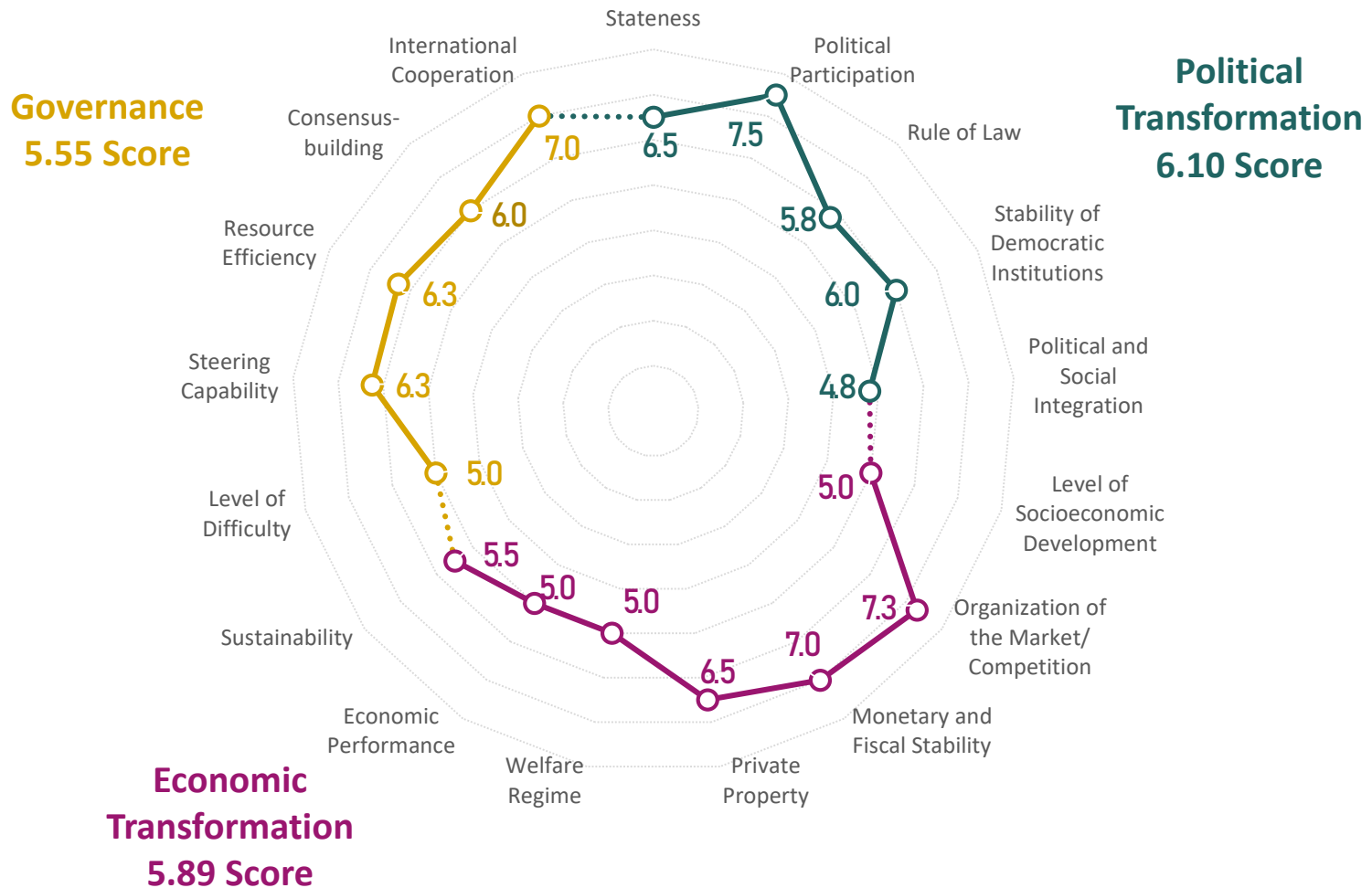

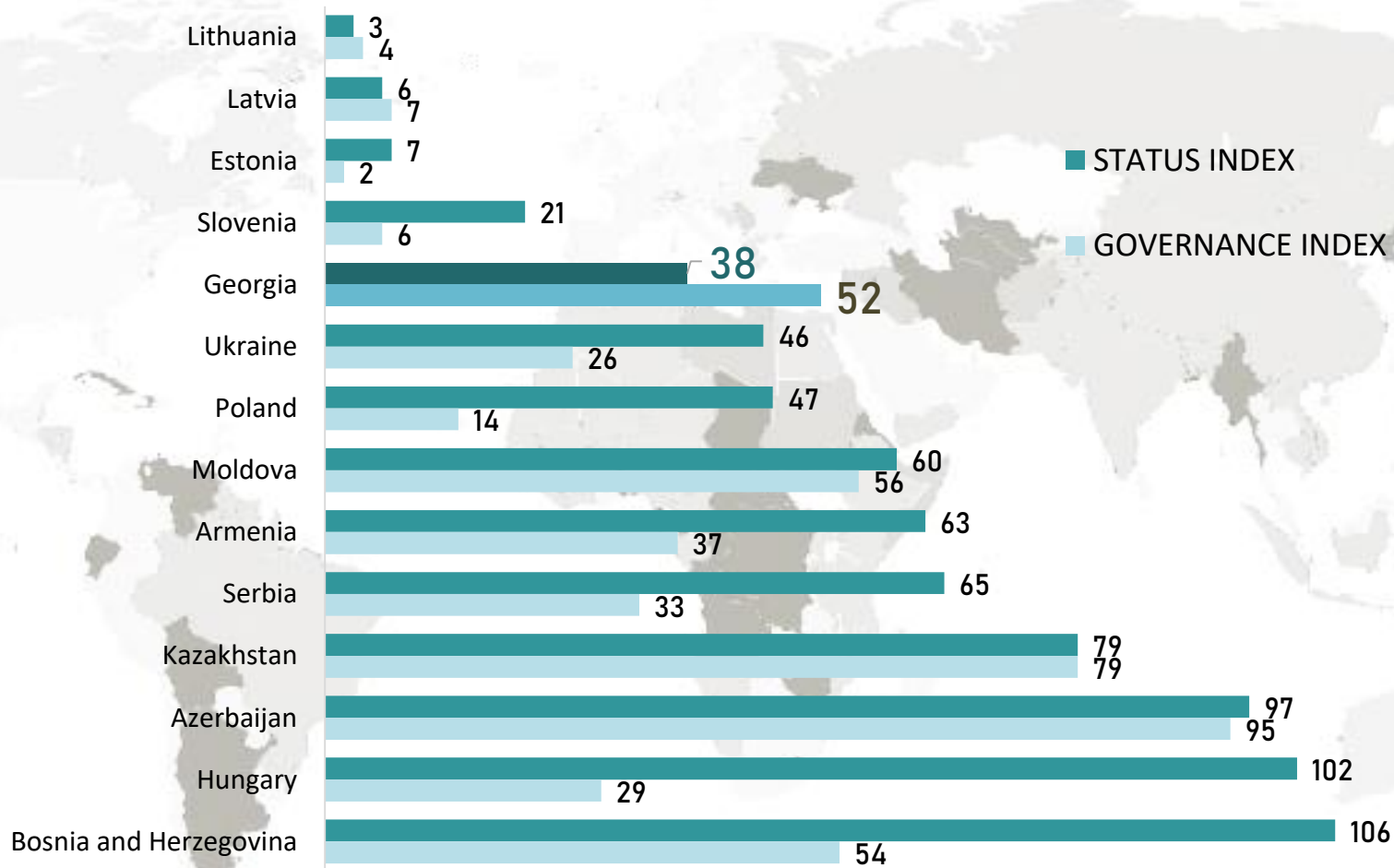

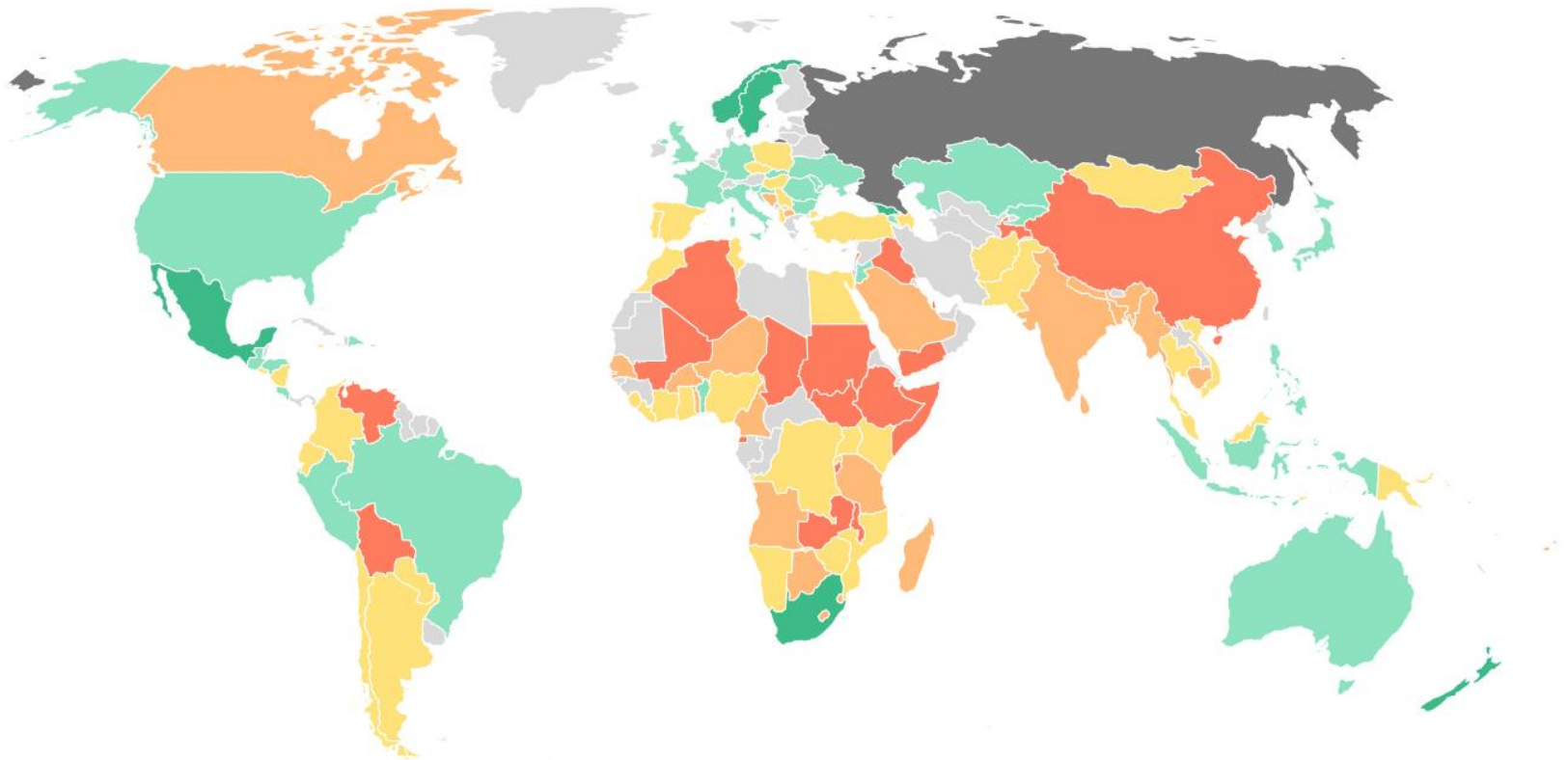
Georgia's Score by Factors

Georgia's Score Compared to Other Countries



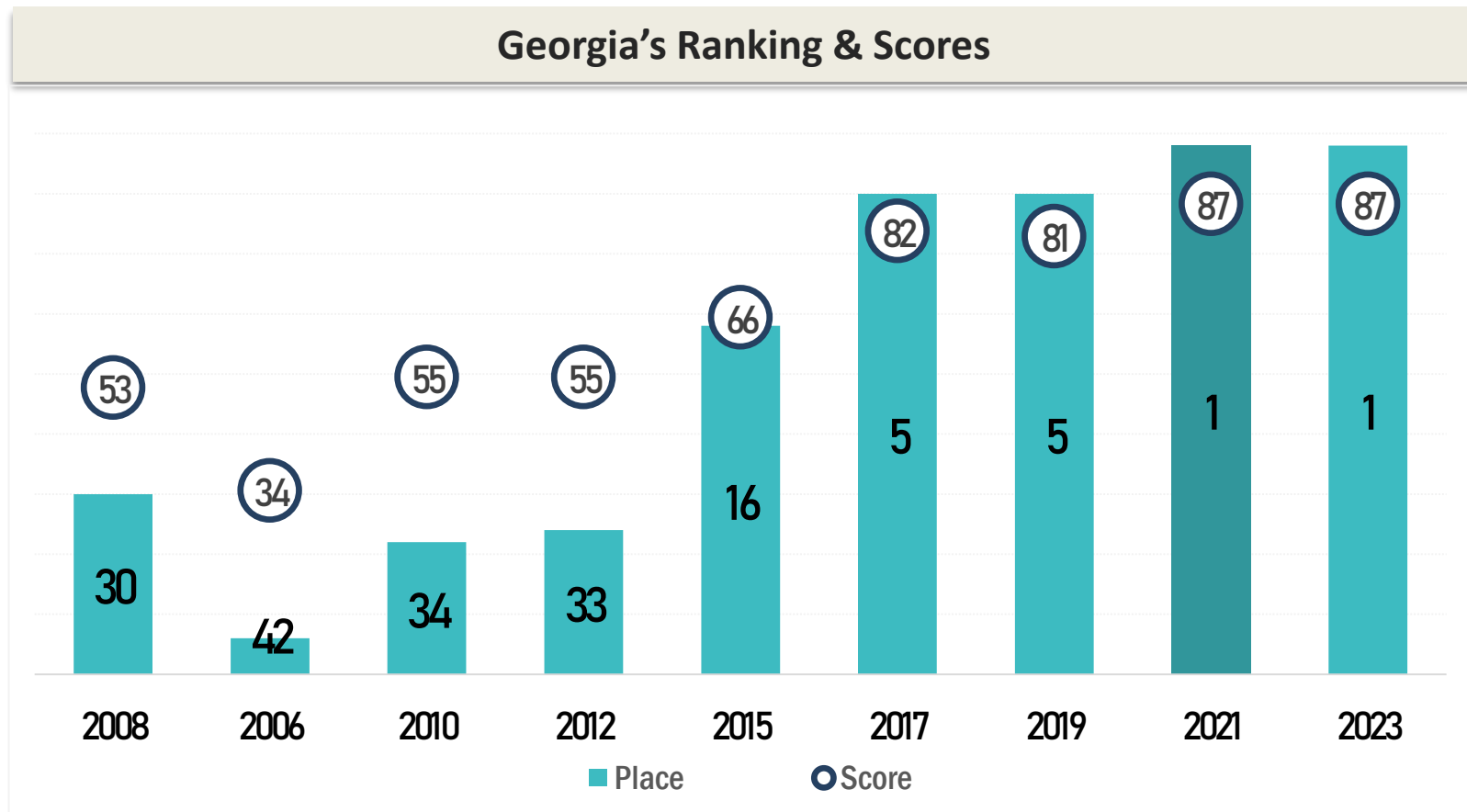

The Open Budget Survey (OBS) assesses the three components of a budget accountability system: public availability of budget information; opportunities for the public to participate in the budget process; and the role and effectiveness of formal oversight institutions, including the legislature and the national audit office

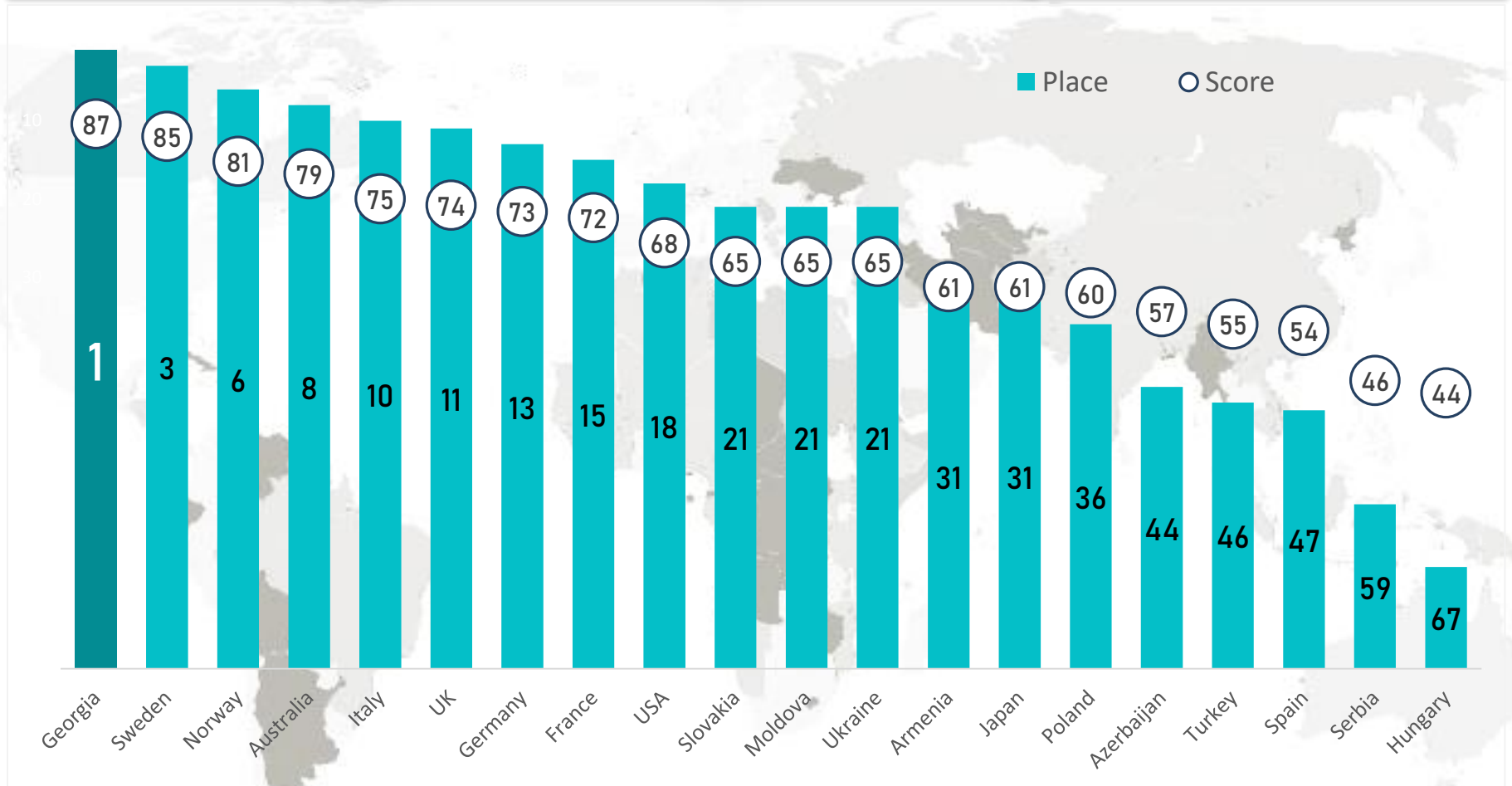

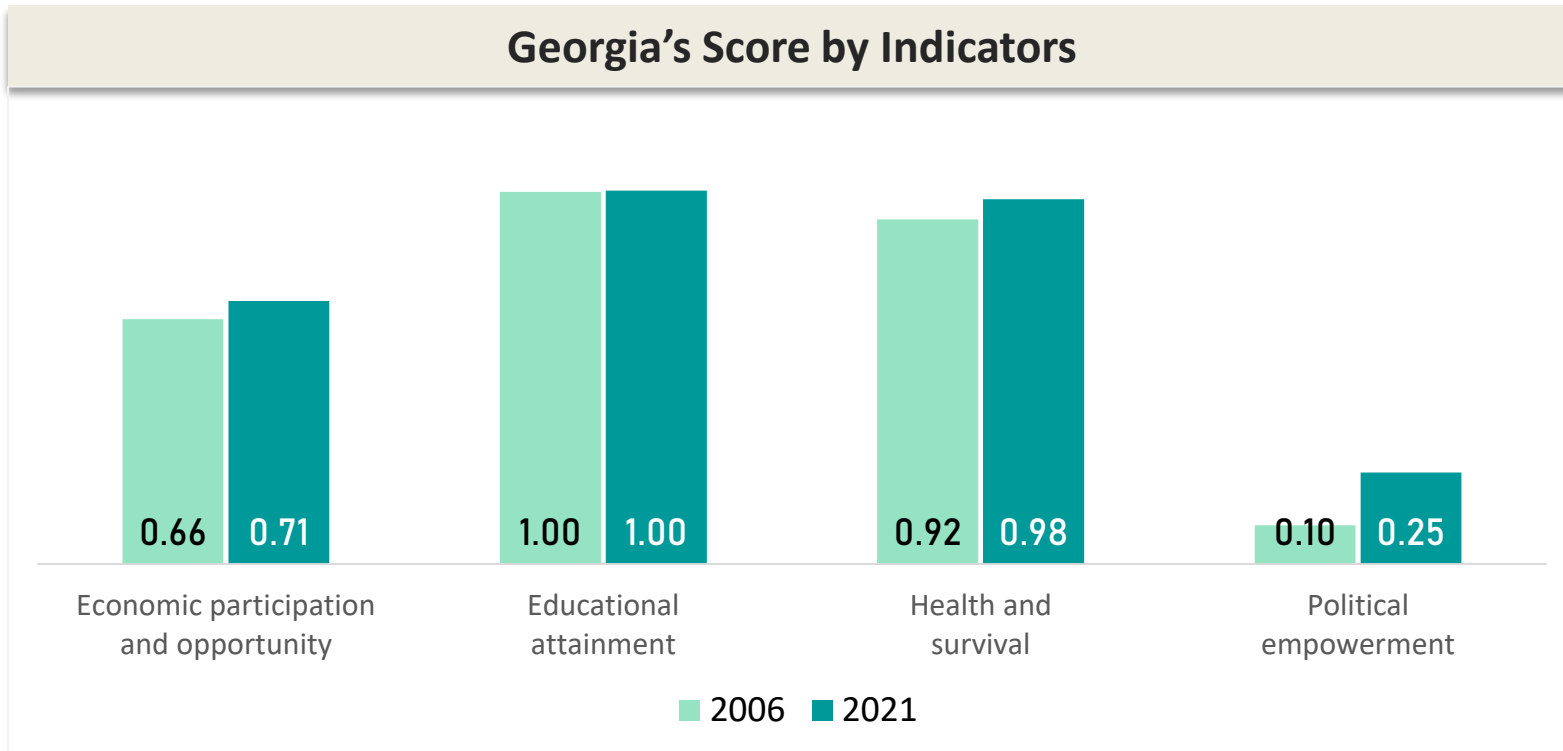
